**Explanation of Responses:**

Pursuant to investment management agreements ("IMAs") between itself and its "Family Clients" (as defined in the Family Office Rule), Reporting Person exercises voting and dispositive power with respect to the Issuer's common stock, par value \$0.0001 per share, held by each of the Family Clients. The Reporting Person also reports beneficial ownership pursuant to Rule 13d-1 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, pursuant to a Schedule 13D previously filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 4, 2019, as amended.
- Represents securities beneficially owned by Reporting Person through an IMA entered into with a Family Client. The securities as to which this Form 4 is filed by Reporting Person are owned of record by Cap 1 LLC, a Family Client of Reporting Person ("Cap 1"). Cap 1 is wholly owned by Crystal Fiduciary Company, LLC, as Trustee of the AR Irrevocable Trust. Reporting Person has no pecuniary interest in the securities beneficially owned by the Family Clients of Reporting Person.
